RGC Collaborative Research Fund (CRF) 2025/26: Pre-announcement and Internal Support

Being deemed as a gateway to obtaining RGC large-scale research grants, the <u>Collaborative Research Fund (CRF)</u> aims to support research groups to engage in creative and high-quality inter-disciplinary / inter-institutional projects. The overall budget for CRF has indeed doubled over the past 5 years and reached HK\$280 million in 2024/25.

The Young Collaborative Research Grant (YCRG) will be regularized with a ring-fenced budget of HK\$50 million starting from 2025/26 exercise. Furthermore, **the institutional quota for YCRG will be removed** in order to encourage more young researchers to embark on collaborative research. A two-stage application process, similar to the project and equipment grants under CRF will be adopted. As an enhancement, proposals eligible for YCRG will be given an additional opportunity for selection under the YCRG track after competing with the normal-track CRF proposals.

The call for 2025/26 applications will be issued in January 2025. The University appeals to researchers to start off planning for it. To encourage quality submission, a support programme is provided by the University which includes:

- CRF Briefing Session (see below for details)
- Internal Mentorship Arrangement
- Funding for External Review Services
- Archive of application materials of awarded CRF for reference upon request (<u>Link</u>)

In addition, the following incentive schemes specifically for CRF will be in place:

- For each successful CRF.
 - a) up to HK\$500,000 matching grant under the Group Research Scheme (GRS)
 - b) HK\$20,000 under Research Incentive Scheme (RIS)
 - c) 3 RPg places allocated to the Faculty
- Seed fund to applications that entered RGC selection interview stage
